Leading Edge draws energy primarily from highly digestible fibre sources called "super fibres" and multiple fat sources including flax, soy oil, and rice bran. Leading Edge has a controlled starch and sugar level making it ideal for training young horses. The controlled NSC formula helps reduce muscle problems while the multiple fat sources and "super fibres" still provide substantial energy for active performance horses.

Leading Edge has earned a reputation among many top trainers and owners for supplying total nutrition in a very palatable form that horses take to readily and stay on during training and competition.

Feeding Suggestions

Feed horses according to level and type of activity and to maintain ideal body condition.

Note: Warmblood and Draft type horses may require different amounts from light horse breeds. Contact a Brooks Feed representative or submit a request on our interactive web site.

Amount of feed required is dependent on the body condition, the metabolism and the type of activity that the horse is used for. For each pound of *Leading Edge* fed daily below $\frac{1}{2}$ pound per 100 pounds of the horse's bodyweight add ¹/₄ pound (115 grams) Brooks Enhancer or All Phase 20. For specific feeding recommendations consult a Brooks Feed representative or submit a request on-line using our interactive feeding guide. Provide fresh clean water and free choice salt at all times with a minimum of 1% of the horse's bodyweight in hay or equivalent pasture. Store in a cool dry location. Amount fed varies according to the quality of hay or pasture. Hay analysis is recommended to ensure a balanced ration.
